Full Bloom, released on 9 September 2022, is Music Vox's follow up album to their 'Beginnings' EP album release in 2020. This album is made up of 8 original songs written, produced and recorded in Temasek Polytechnic. It also includes the original National Day Song 'Spread The Light' written specially for the TP National Day Concert in 2021. More than 50 people contributed to the lyrics of the song and it was finally performed live during TP's National Day Concert 2022. The members and alumni worked tirelessly the past year to put this album together and is finally released on all major streaming platforms such as Spotify, Apple Music, YouTube Music and Deezer.

The album is a culmination of the musical exploration and sheer dedication of Music Vox's members, a tremendous showcase of what the album's name 'Full Bloom' represents. From heart-wrenching rock ballads to candy-sweet bossa nova voicings, Full Bloom promises something for everyone with Singapore's up and coming young talent.

The jazzy tunes don't rest just yet - alumna vocalist Sarah and alumnus guitarist Calvin take the stage with 'Time & Chance', reminding us that through ever-changing times and unprecedented situations, life would continue on. The percussive instrumentation and unique melody line gives rise to musical unorthodoxy that is sure to keep you hooked from start to finish!

The vocals pause momentarily as 'Overjoyed' makes its mark at the halfway point of the album, as guitarist Brendon, bassist Joshua and drummer Justin's high energy instrumentals provide a refreshing interlude to cleanse one's palate before the second half of the album. The hard-hitting drums, pulsating bass beats and riveting guitars showcase a unique arrangement and perspective of breaking through creative limits within a single album.



10 Steps' expresses the realisation of a new love interest and facing it by telling the whole world except that one person, using music as an outlet to come to terms with the budding feelings. Singer-songwriter Masha, vocalist Regine, guitarists Caitlyn and Terence and keyboardist Terence deliver this public-confession-to-everyone-but-that-one-person in its bubbly, vulnerable, but light-hearted tone that seeks to relate to people on a warm, affectionate, innocent level. The soft, lilting melody brings comfort in candidness, conveying the blossoming feelings in a dream-like manner.

The resounding guitar on 'We Thank You' signals the listener's recollection of what was perhaps the most difficult period of time in modern Singapore, the pandemic. However, if the name is any clue, the song chooses to focus on honouring the frontline workers that fought the virus tirelessly to keep civilians safe throughout the gruelling two years. Singer-songwriter Aniq's ode to all frontline workers serves a timely reminder to not take our safety for granted, and to appreciate our modern-day superheroes that continue to serve the nation with committed dedication.

'Last Words' closes the album in its melancholy and reflectiveness, leading listeners to reminisce periods of transition into new stages of life. For 'Last Words', expresses the very prominent uncertainty stemming from going on different paths after completing a milestone in life, and aims to bring comfort to those who feel alone in their life's journey. Singer-songwriter Masha, vocalists Mavis and Jena, guitarists Dhruv and Clarissa, keyboardist Pye Oo and drummer Nicholas deliver this emotive close, aptly delivering the last words of this album.
